<b>Fogbelt Brewing</b> <b>Bamboozle Golden Milk Stout (12 oz)</b> Barrel aged in bourbon barrels for four months with added Madagascar vanilla beans & coffee giving this stout a dry coffee nose and smooth vanilla coffee taste. ABV 9.2% IBU 16	\$20
<b>Henhouse Brewing</b> <b>A Honest Days Work, Red Rye Saison (16oz)</b> A little bit of spicy German hops on the nose, some toffee, it's like plum jam on rye toast. ABV 7.0%	\$9
<b>Henhouse Brewing</b> <b>Best Life, Blond Ale (16oz)</b> An extraordinary everyday beer! The gentle hop aroma is a magical complement to a life well lived. Make every day extraordinary, live your best life! ABV 4.5%	\$9
